COVID-19 Code of Conduct policy updates:

Jeppe High School for Boys remains committed to ensuring the safety of all persons who enter the campus. As such we have drawn up strict guidelines and procedures in our COVID-19 School and Boarding Policy documents.

Any learner who does not adhere to the safety measures put in place by the school and the government regarding COVID-19 may receive the appropriate demerits, may be subject to a school IDC or may be requested by the headmaster to leave the campus with immediate effect and be refused entry to Jeppe High School for Boys for continued non-compliance. In such cases a learner will be required to work remotely at home until he demonstrates that he is prepared to follow the necessary guidelines and safety principles. Not adhering to the safety principles would include but is not limited to:

- Not wearing a facemask or not having a facemask at school.
- Not adhering to social distancing protocols.
- Not adhering to the regulations around sanitising.
- Not adhering to daily screening protocols and questions
- Not adhering to the medical processes and protocols concerning COVID-19 that have been put in place
- Not adhering to COVID-19 policies in place in the boarding houses

Until further notice, school tracksuits will be allowed to be worn to school in addition to school uniform should parents opt for more regular washing of blazers and items of school uniform.

Whilst some flexibility will be allowed with regards to the hair policy due to lockdown regulations restricting hairdressers, boys are still expected to have neat hairstyles and be clean-shaven. Boys whose hairstyles do not conform with school rules may be required to wear school tracksuits.

Selling of any items on school premises by any learner is strictly prohibited as this could pose serious health and safety risks towards the school community.

COVID-19 related policies and processes have been put in place to ensure the safety of all persons on the Jeppe campus and to ensure the continued running of the school and the academic program. Failure to adhere to COVID-19 protocols will be viewed in a very serious light.
