Dear Jeppe parents,

There is much excitement as we stand on the brink of a return to school of all grades, albeit on an alternate day model, next week. The School Management Team have been at school the whole week preparing for the return of the boys whilst the entire educator body also returned to school today so as to ensure we are well prepared for the return of all five grades on Monday.

As promised in my letter of last week, I also wanted to update all parents on a number of practical and logistical matters pertaining to the school calendar, and daily operations, for the remainder of the year.

From a calendar perspective, please take note of the following:

- As mentioned in my last letter, the Department of Education confirmed that the 2020 school year will be completed in December 2020, with schools officially closing on Tuesday, 15th December, and re-opening on Monday, 25th January 2021 (for educators, and likely Wednesday, 27th January 2021 for learners).
- Revised term dates were also provided with a break of one week being allocated at the end of October (school will break up on Friday, 23rd October and return on Monday, 2nd November).

From a Jeppe perspective, this break is well-timed and can effectively be used by all grades as a “one week study break” in advance of the year end examinations.

- With the finalisation of the calendar, we are also now able to finalise planning for Term 3 assessments and the year end exam timetable. In this regard, please take note of the following:
  - The matric prelim exams will commence on Monday, 7th September, a week later than provisionally scheduled. These exams, which will finish on Friday, 2nd October, will then be followed by at least three weeks of critical exam feedback and remediation whereat matric attendance will be crucially important, before a one week break on Friday, 23rd October as referred to above. It is our intention to hold an intensive matric academic camp in the one week October break to assist matrics. Further information will follow in this regard directly to matrics and their parents.

- For Grade 8 - 11, there will be an “Exam Block” during Term 3 commencing Wednesday, 16th Sept for some grades (Gr 8 start on Mon, Sept 21) to Friday, Oct 2nd using a day on, day off model to allow for social distancing.

Exam timetables for matric prelim exams and the Gr8-11 Exam Block will be issued to boys upon their return to school next week.

- The matric final exam timetable was also finalised and issued by the Department of Education during the course of the last week and will be issued to matrics next week. These final exams officially commence on Thursday, 5th November (English) and end on Tuesday, 15th December (Visual Art) but Life Orientation, CAT and IT (Pracs) are all written in the week of 19th - 23rd October prior to the week-long October break.
- Grade 8 - 11 final examinations will commence on Monday, 9th November with the final exam being written on Friday, 4th December but will also be preceded by certain practical examinations (e.g. Life Science and Visual Art).
- In order to ensure they are adequately prepared for the final examinations, boys who did poorly in Term 2 and those who did not cope with online learning will be expected to remain after school in Term 3 in order to participate in an afternoon remediation programme to ensure that they have caught up work that has been missed. Heads of Grade and subject educators will communicate more information in this regard to the boys and parents involved.
- Term 2 reports will, as previously communicated, be issued by Friday, 21st August.

I also want to make parents aware of the following:

- Grade 9 learners typically choose their subjects for the Gr 10-12 FET phase in August of each year and following a “Grade 9 Subject Choices” evening held in the Memorial Hall. Due to COVID-19 regulations, holding such a meeting, with 200 boys and their parents will obviously not be possible this year and we are therefore developing a “website” which will contain, inter alia, a brochure on the various subjects, an explanation of selection criteria and the ability to then choose subject selections online and remotely. A letter will be sent to Grade 9 parents in this regard by the end of August.
- We are acutely aware of the disappointment felt by the matrics at missing out on so many milestones in their final year due to COVID-19. As such, we are examining various options regarding their final assembly and what could potentially be done with regards to a Valediction ceremony. There are a number of factors which affect the scheduling and format of these events, including social distancing requirements, the scheduled LO, IT and CAT exams in the week of Monday, 19th October and the later-than-usual third term break. We will communicate progress in this regard as soon as possible.
- Of course, it is not just matric students who have missed out on great experiences and opportunities. Further communication will be sent in the coming weeks regarding the proposed 2021 European Academic Tour (likely to be delayed to 2022), the Grade 9

Journey (likely to be delayed to the end of 2021) and possible arrangements for the Grade 7 Information evening and Induction camp.

**Regarding logistics for next week, please note the following:**

**In keeping with the previous rotations, GROUP 2 will attend school on Monday, 17th August and GROUP 1 will begin the term of Tuesday, 18th August - continuing on the ALTERNATE DAY system.**

**MORNING REGISTRATION:** Parents will know that we have continued with both thermometer and question screening since the return of our matrics on 8th June. The process has been both necessary and efficient and is something which will continue when the boys return on Monday, 17th August.

**Grade 11 and Grade 12 Registration will take place in the Memorial Hall Foyer.  
Grade 8, Grade 9 and Grade 10 Registration will take place in the Payne Hall.**

Despite the additional number of students we have been able to continue using the two separate venues due to the fact that boarders are able to complete their morning checks in their hostels (saving them from having to do it twice) and the continued 'Alternate Day' programme, with only half a grade present on any one day. Registration is open from 7AM and will end at 7:55AM, ahead of Period 1 at 8AM.

Students who arrive late for school will be required to complete registration in Centenary House with Mr Green.

**TIMETABLES:** Students will receive their timetable on Monday morning, beginning with Day 1 on the two week cycle. As per previous timetables, school will finish at either 1:40PM or 2:35PM for students.

Please note that Period 7 (2:30PM) is not optional and any students who are found to bunk this final lesson of the day will be punished accordingly.

**BREAK TIMES:** In order to help maintain social distancing, Grade 8s and Grade 9s will make use of the bottom fields and stands at break time with the Grade 10, Grade 11 and Grade 12 students continuing as they have been on the top fields.

Six staff members are allocated break duties each day and will be on hand to ensure, as far as possible, that students adhere to the necessary guidelines. Once again, while we are committed to monitoring as much as possible the ultimate responsibility for personal safety lies with the individual and we ask that parents continue to support us in instilling that with the boys - during breaks and throughout their daily lives.

**TUCKSHOP:** For the time being we remain committed to doing what we can to support the tuckshop for our students. Realistically, however, a traditional school tuckshop is not possible. For this reason we will continue with the pre-order system. Students **MUST** complete and submit their orders for the day before 8AM. We ask boys not to ask or pressure the tuckshop staff into selling them items during the day. The staff have often been put in this unfair position at times and it could result in us having to limit the facility further moving forward. Junior students will be able to collect their orders from the Watson Pavillion while the senior students will be able to collect from the normal tuckshop hatches - each section designated for

the three grades which are present.

It would be remiss of me to not take this opportunity to mention Women's Month. I would sincerely like to express our appreciation and gratitude to all the phenomenal women within the Jeppe community. As a school we are incredibly fortunate to be able to boast a staff room, support team and administrative department which includes truly fantastic women and their roles in our school can never be overstated, whilst we also want to acknowledge and appreciate the role that our moms, grandmothers, sisters and aunts play in the lives of our boys.

Jeppe is not the same without all our young men on campus. I once again commend the overwhelming majority who have returned to campus and am confident that the coming months will be academically challenging, rewarding and worthwhile for all our students.

We continue to hold all those families who have lost someone in their lives to COVID-19 in our thoughts and prayers. There is no doubt that many individuals, families and communities continue to struggle and we remain committed to supporting all those as best we can. These are indeed very difficult times but there is no doubt in my mind that we, as a community and as individuals, will endure and overcome these challenges as best we can.
