NOTICE OF NOMINATION AND THE ELECTION MEETING FOR SCHOOL GOVERNING BODY (SGB) – PARENTS

Notice is hereby given that, as previously communicated in the school newsletter of Tuesday, 30th March, the headmaster's letter of Friday, 12th March and the SGB Parent Information Meeting on Wednesday, 31st March, a meeting for the election of nominees for PARENT members of the governing body of JEPPE HIGH SCHOOL FOR BOYS will be held on **Wednesday, 14th April from 6PM in the Memorial Hall.**

Nominations will take place from Tuesday, 6th April until 3PM on Monday, 12th April. In addition, there will be a final opportunity, between 5.30PM – 6PM on Wednesday, 14th April, in the Memorial Hall, where final nominations, if any, can be presented.

Nomination forms will be available at the school from Mrs. Thompson's office.

Please note the following regarding nominations:

- For parent nominees, the proposer and the seconder must be parent/legal guardians of learners at the school.
- Nominees must be parents that are not employed at the school.
- The nomination form must be returned to the school by no later than 3PM on Monday, 12th April or between 5.30PM – 6PM in the Memorial Hall on the evening of Wednesday, 14th April. The nomination form must be placed in the sealed nomination box which is kept in Mrs Thompson's office.
- **The proposer needs to ensure that (in addition to their signature) a seconder and the candidate (nominee) sign the form before returning it to the school and placing it in the nomination box.**

NB: It is the responsibility of the nominee and the voter to ensure that their names are on the school's voters' roll, which can be viewed in Mrs. Thompson's Office during school hours from Tuesday, 6th April until the elections are concluded.

An election will only be held if more people are nominated than the number of parents (nine) that are required to be elected for the SGB. Should an election be held, a quorum of 15% of parents/legal guardians on the voters' roll is required to be present at the election (no proxy votes are allowed).

Should a quorum of 15% of parents/legal guardians not be present on Wednesday, 14th April at the election meeting, and an election is required to be held as more than nine nominations are received, then a follow up election will be required. The date for this contingency follow up election is 6PM on Wednesday, 21st April.

Should an election be required, the nominated parents/legal guardians will be given an opportunity to present, for no longer than 2 minutes, their credentials for election to the SGB as a parent member. This will include the nine current parent SGB members, all of whom have indicated that they will be available for re-election.

Two parents or guardians may vote per family. Please bring your ID (Green barcoded or smart card) or valid passport to vote. No other form of identification will be accepted.
